The First & Second Grade students have had a lot of fun in Theater so far this term! In Term 1, they have been learning how to use their faces and bodies to communicate emotions. The students have done a great job developing facial expressions to show feelings. They've worked with partners to "mirror" what they see, they've played guessing games, and we've read several stories while acting out what the characters are feeling (the most noteworthy books that were lots of fun include Alexander and the Terrible, Horrible, No Good, Very Bad Day by Judith Viorst and Today I Feel Silly by Jamie Lee Curtis (completely unrelated to Mr. Curtis upstairs in Grade 5). Ask your First or Second Grader to show you some faces – they are quite good! Soon we will learn the best way to use our voice (diction, projection, and expression) in acting....laying the foundation for some good acting coming in the future. I can't wait!
