What does it mean?

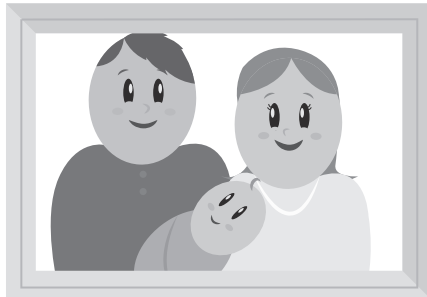
Baptism is a symbol of how God has given us new life in Christ and joined us with Him and the Church.

Eating the bread and drinking of the cup to remember the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus as we also look forward to His coming kingdom.

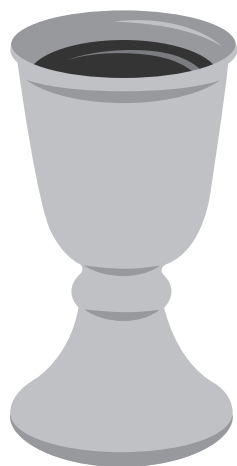
What does the bread represent?

The blood of Jesus that was shed on the cross for the forgiveness of our sins.



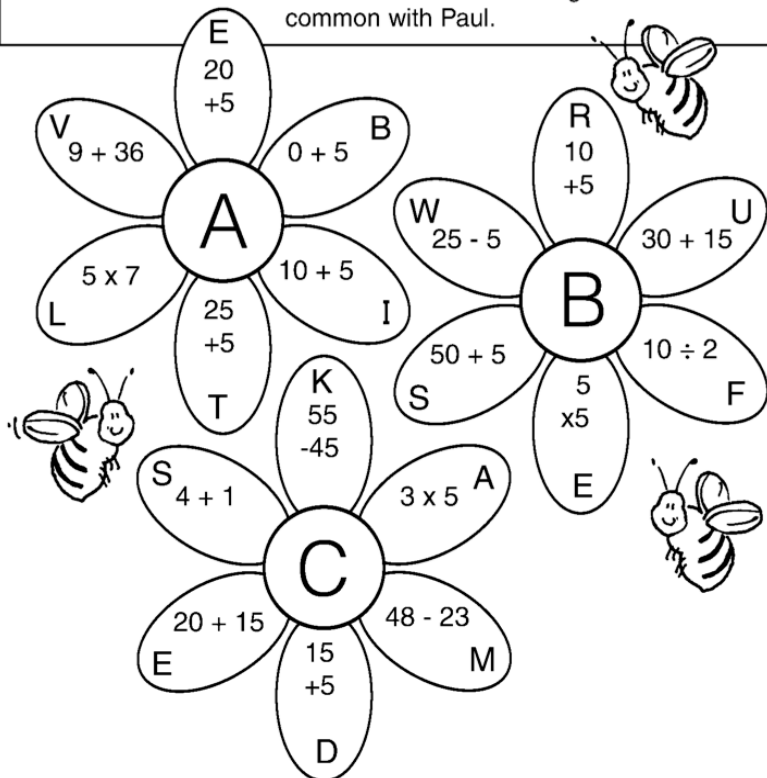

I can mimic a swimming fish with my hands... Ask me to show you!

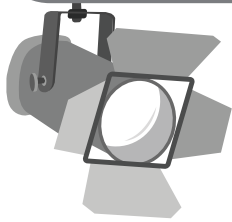

Worship: 


