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Basic Quilting Class

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Basic quilting class is a beginner's class:

How to use **Rotary Cutters**
Squaring up fabric
Making Templates
Making blocks with & without templates
Piecing
Borders
Putting the Quilt together
Quilting
Binding

You can make a 4 block wall hanging or a table runner unfinished block size is 12-1/2"

Supply List:

- Sewing machine
- $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot
- Walking foot
- Darning foot
- Rotary cutter & mat
- Rulers:
- 6" x 24"
- 12-1/2" square up
- Straight pins
- Safety pins
- Kwik klip
- Marking pencils or pens to mark quilt top for quilting
- Template plastic
- Template marking pencil
- Neutral thread 100% cotton or poly covered cotton
- Invisible thread clear or smoke (Sulky)

*Fabric:

- Scraps of fabric for making 4 (12-1/2") blocks or 4 or 5 different color fat quarters
- Backing Fabric can be muslin if you prefer, a new quilter might want a busy print,
- will determine the yardage when the top is complete (about 2 yds.)
- Sashing fabric 1 yd.
- Cornerstone fabric Fat 1/8's
- Border fabric 1-1/2 yds.
- Binding fabric 3/8 yd.
- Batting I prefer warm & white or warm & natural for machine quilting (same yardage as backing)

*Note these yardage figures are approximate and reflect very little margin for error...if in doubt go up $\frac{1}{4}$ yd. in cornerstones, $\frac{1}{2}$ yd. in sashing, $\frac{1}{2}$ yd. in binding $\frac{1}{2}$ yd. in border

Personally I always purchase more fabric than I think I'll need for a project and I prefer the flexibility of having too much versus not enough...just in case I change my mind mid way through the project...which I've been known to do...
