Repurposed Sweat Shirt

Supply list

Join us in making a beautiful sweater out of a plain, drab sweat shirt !

You will need:

- Sewing machine and embroidery w/embroidery attachment and 200 x 200 hoop or larger*
- Accessories for your machine (power cord, foot control, decorative sewing foot (B), embroidery foot
- 2 or 3 spools of Floriani embroidery thread (please make sure that 1 matches the color of the sweat top (White, grey or light pink sweatshirt only Please). *
- Sweat Top (give your normal sweatshirt size) #
- 8 - ½" coordinating, decorative buttons#
- Fusible No-show Mesh Stabilizer #
- Bobbin filled with bobbin embroidery thread *
- 1 embroidery and 1 Ball Point Needle *#
- Sewing supplies*

Cutting Instructions for sweatshirt:

1. Find centered vertical line of sweatshirt and cut down front of sweatshirt.
2. Cut off sleeve ribbed cuffs, bottom ribbing and neckline ribbing near the stitching.
3. ***If you are not confident, the cutting process can be cut during class.***
