



**DONATION NEEDS:**

From time to time, we have temporary specific needs, which can be found posted on our Facebook page or website ([www.pilgrimsinn.org](http://www.pilgrimsinn.org)) or by calling our main office. However, many items we consistently need are listed below. We appreciate any help with donations of these items.

- **Monetary Support:** Our primary need is always financial support. Monetary donations help us ensure that our critical programs continue to be available for families in our community.
- **Food:** We always need non-perishable food items for our food pantry. This can include canned meats, fruits, vegetables, soups, and boxed goods such as macaroni and cheese, pasta, and rice. We also need breakfast food items such as cereals. We distribute a tremendous amount of food to hungry families each week and our pantry is in constant need of being restocked.
- **Cleaning Supplies:** We use donated supplies both to clean our own premises – including the main building and the shelter – as well as to assist clients who cannot afford cleaning supplies for their home. We can use all manner of supplies, especially bleach, HE laundry detergent, floor cleaner, Lysol spray, dishwashing detergent, dusting spray, and window cleaner.
- **Cleaning Tools:** Due to extensive use, our mops and brooms wear out quickly! We can always use replacements, as well as cleaning cloths, dusters, etc.
- **Paper Goods:** We go through a great deal of toilet paper (1ply), paper towels, napkins, paper plates, etc.
- **Diapers / Wipes:** We always need diapers of all sizes as well as diaper wipes. We use these in our own child care center, as well as assisting clients with children in diapers.
- **Office Supplies:** Our greatest need is copy paper, new t-shirt bags (see below). We also need Envelopes – both business size and smaller. Manila envelopes, post-it notes, tab folders, pocket folders, organizer trays, 3 ring binders of all sizes.
