Why We Serve

York County Free Clinic's mission is to provide compassionate, quality healthcare to the uninsured, eligible adults in York County. It is our vision that York County residents have access to high-quality healthcare, regardless of their ability to pay.

Primary Care



Patients receive chronic, acute, and preventive care. We offer lab procedures and help patients with various diagnoses such as hypertension, diabetes, and high cholesterol. Clinic partners provide colon cancer screenings and other social and educational services.

Medications



Patients receive free medications through Welvista Medication Assistance Program.

Optometry



We provide eye exams and glasses.
