- Progression through these stages may not be strictly linear; we may need to move backwards and forwards as we continue discerning what measures will keep all of us reasonably safe
- The **Congregation Council** may alter the details of any stage at any time, and will make every effort to communicate changes as quickly and effectively as possible
- These stages were established by the **Congregation Council**, following the recommendations of the ELCA, the SC Synod, Grace's pastors, the Health & Wellness Committee, the CDC, SC DHEC, the White House, and other sources of public health information.
