Did you know that there is a proposal to end curbside recycling collection here in Rock Hill starting July 1, 2020? Ending this valuable city service is the alternative to raising sanitation rates 4%; that is less than \$0.80 per month per customer to keep curbside recycling collection as is! Ending curbside recycling collection will reduce recycling collection by city residents and set the city's sustainable efforts back at least 30 years. Recycling in Rock Hill creates jobs throughout the states of North and South Carolina, supports manufacturers throughout the Southeast, reduces landfill waste and pollution, saves energy, and conserves natural resources.
