

NOMINEE BIOS – CONGREGATION COUNCIL

C12.02 The members of the Congregation Council except the pastor(s) shall be elected by written ballot to serve for three years or until their successors are elected. Such members shall be eligible to serve no more than two full terms consecutively. Their terms shall begin on the date the Congregational Council is installed, as specified in the By-Laws, and shall end when their successors are installed.

C12.03 Should a member's place on the Congregation Council be declared vacant, the Congregation Council shall elect, by majority vote, a successor until the next annual business meeting. If less than three months remain until the next annual meeting, the Congregation Council may choose to allow the vacancy to remain, and the Congregation shall elect a member to fill the unexpired term.

Additional nominations may be made from the floor during the Annual Meeting with the prior consent of the nominee.

This year, all Council nominees are presented in the order of the month in which they were born.
