The worksite location is **432 S. Confederate St., Rock Hill**. We will be refurbishing a home for a family, likely doing inside painting as part of the day.

Please note the age requirement is 18 or older; youth 16-17 may volunteer with a guardian volunteering alongside them.

We are also asked to provide lunch for our group and 8 crew members. If you're interested in helping to provide lunch, please contact Doug Gay.

Workday Outline:

7:45 am: Registration Table is open.

8:00 am: Volunteer arrives, sign in, and receive name tags.

8:15 am: Welcome, staff & lead volunteers' introductions, safety procedures & tasks review.

8:30 am: Workday begins, break into work groups.

11:30 am: 30 Minute lunch break; Volunteers enjoy rest and fellowship.

12:00 pm: After lunch, work for the day continues until the day's tasks are completed.

3:00 pm: Workday ends. Please note the day may end earlier if all tasks are completed.

Helpful Workday Reminders:

- Bring a foldable chair to use for your break or you can tailgate on your vehicles.
- Volunteers should take breaks as needed and are encouraged to drink water regularly to stay **hydrated**. Volunteers can bring a folding chair to use for breaks and lunch. Please do not bring the chairs over to the worksite-leave inside your vehicle until needed.
- Please don't forget to wear comfortable (but not baggy clothes) and closed-toed shoes. Wear an old hat if you would like to protect your hair. No loose jewelry!
- Parking: On the street parking will be available. Do not block the driveway of the construction site nor neighboring houses or businesses. Please carpool if you are volunteering with another volunteer.
- In case of inclement weather, we will contact the group leader the morning of the event, to confirm that the workday is still on.

How to register:

Please register prior to the event and review the Volunteer Liability Waiver prior to arriving on the worksite as this will help speed up the sign-in process.
