

Making Your Safety a Top Priority

Art Miami + CONTEXT Art Miami protocols around health & safety include all participants to **EITHER** have a negative COVID-19 test obtained within 72 hours of arriving at the event **OR** have proof of full vaccination obtained no later than 14 days prior to arriving at the event.

See below for details.

- Everyone entering Art Miami + CONTEXT Art Miami will align with the protocols; inclusive of attendees, exhibitors, show management, show contracted vendors and employees, visitors, guests. Everyone.
- Attendees aged 12 and over must provide proof of a negative lab-administered COVID-19 test in order to gain access to Art Miami + CONTEXT Art Miami. Alternatively, attendees may opt to voluntarily provide proof of completed COVID-19 vaccination or proof of recent (within 90 days) recovery from COVID-19 issued by a board-certified physician or medical treatment facility - to gain entry. For attendees 18 and over, documentation shown must match photo ID provided at entry. **To enter the fair each day, attendees must show EITHER** a negative Covid-19 test obtained within 72 hours of arriving at the event **OR** have proof of full vaccination obtained no later than 14 days prior to arriving at the event.
 - Negative COVID -19 Test verification:
 - PCR/NAAT taken within 72 hours prior to arriving at Art Miami + CONTEXT Art Miami
 - Antigen (rapid) taken within 72 hours prior to arriving at Art Miami + CONTEXT Art Miami
 - Home tests may only be used if also certified by a medical professional or lab technician
 - Vaccination status can be verified in the following ways:
 - Proof via an app; Excelsior, Clear, Dept of Health Digital Record, CommonPass, VeriFLY
 - Hard copy of your vaccination record
 - A clear photocopy of your vaccination record – front and back
 - A clear picture or digital copy of your vaccination record – front and back
 - *People are considered fully vaccinated: 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson’s Janssen vaccine
 - Acceptable vaccination documentation:
 - Documentation that you have completed all recommended doses of a COVID-19 vaccine that has been authorized or approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) or is listed for emergency use by the World Health Organization (WHO) at least 2 weeks prior to the start of the fair. This currently includes the following vaccines:
 - Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine
 - Pfizer-BioNTech (COMIRNATY) COVID-19 Vaccine
 - Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine
 - Johnson and Johnson’s Janssen COVID-19 Vaccine
 - AstraZeneca COVID-19 Vaccine (COVISHIELD)
 - Sinopharm BIBP COVID-19 Vaccine
 - Sinovac-CoronaVac COVID-19 Vaccine
 - Screening will be done by a 3rd party official vendor, United Security. Checks will be visual only with no information recorded or documented.
 - After satisfying your health screening, you will be given an event wristband to be worn throughout your day at the fair

- Once you have your wristband you will be directed to proceed through security and to scan your ticket at the fair entrance. .

Mask Mandate

All Attendees, Exhibitors, Vendors & Colleagues will be required to wear a face covering while in the Art Miami and CONTEXT Art Miami fairs.

- It is **mandatory** to wear masks anywhere inside the fairs with the exception of when eating and drinking.
- Approved face coverings include:
 - A mask or 2 layered secured cloth that completely covers your nose and mouth and fits snugly to the sides of your face and under your chin.
 - Face shields worn with a face covering, but not in place of one.
- These are not acceptable face coverings:
 - Balaclavas
 - Bandanas
 - Face covers with exhaust valves or vents
 - Face covers made of mesh or lace type fabric
 - Face shields
 - Gaiters
 - Scarves
 - Ski masks
