We continue to see God's amazing faithfulness in building His church in our SPA region. There are thirteen new plants/potential plants in process and the majority are from our own Greenhouse Churches (churches that help to raise up leaders and plant new churches). TO GO CHURCH—In Tucson, Arizona



This young church is “going out” to bring the Gospel to neighborhoods in their community. Launched during Covid, they started hosting services in their community’s park and “by God’s grace, we have been able to have safe open air services. Each week we do something different. 1st Sunday is a sermon, 2nd Sunday is a prayer service, 3rd Sunday is outreach, 4th is Sunday evangelism.” God put it on their hearts to be more intentional about building relationships in the neighborhood surrounding the park so they went door-to-door meeting neighbors, inviting them and had several opportunities to pray with people.

NEW LIFE CHURCH—In Woodland Hills, CA

We’re thrilled to see and celebrate the ministry of New Life Church, who just celebrated their 10th anniversary. They were a Fresh Start planted with assistance from Community Christian Alliance Church. Early on, *New Life* caught the vision for planting churches. They began a Greenhouse training program to raise up new leaders. Their intern program is very active, has a Greenhouse coordinator on staff, and a growing list of applicants. They’ve sent out three church planting couples, two in the U.S. and one to India. Two other couples are now heading out to plant in Estonia and Ethiopia. Praise God!
