Main entrance to Russell at the corner of 1st Street and Constitution Ave NE. Please note there is construction going on so there is scaffolding around the entrance and this side of Russell. But the entrance is still open and accessible. This entrance actually brings you in on the second floor so once you pass security use the elevator or stairs to go down to the 1st floor and then follow signs to room SR 167.

The U.S. Capitol | Senate Side | Corner of Constitution & Delaware | Room S-230

Please note, we will be escorted from our meeting with Sen. Paul. Enter at the corner of Constitution and Delaware. We will enter through the Official Appointments "shack" located to the right of the Senate Steps. Credentials will be picked up at the Appointments Desk to get up to Senator McConnell's office.

Cannon House Office Building | Room 303 | Budget Conference Room

Enter Cannon House Office Building at the corner of C Street and First Street SE, you will go through security. Following security, you will go straight down the hall. At the end of the hallway, continue going down the other hallway. When you are almost to the end of that hallway, you will see gold elevators on your right. Take that up to the third floor. When exiting the elevators, take a left. The Budget Conference Room (303 Cannon) will be on your left shortly after exiting the elevators.
