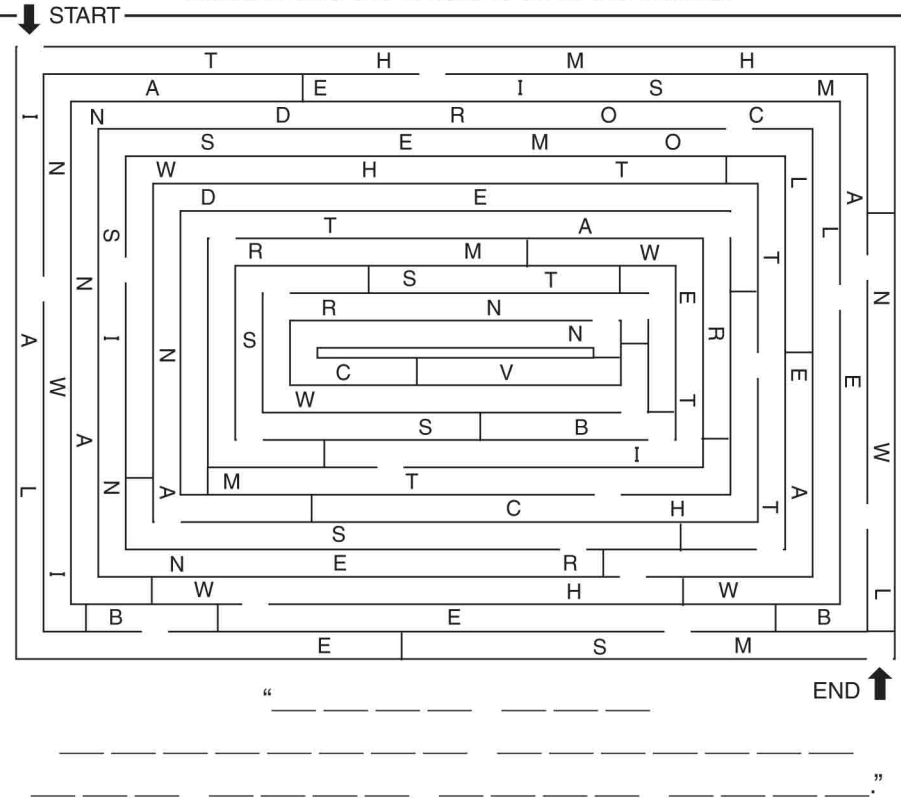

Tax collectors and sinners gathered to hear Jesus. Seeing this, what did the Pharisees and teachers of the law say to themselves?

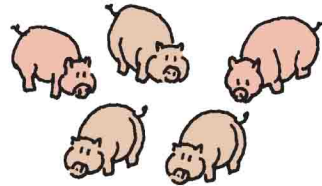
Find the correct path through the maze to find the letters to fill in the blanks.

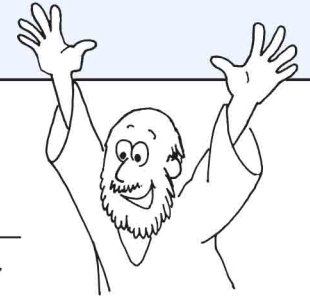
