# Automotive Apprenticeship

## AUTOMOTIVE APPRENTICESHIP

Franklin Cummings Tech offers a year-long, 2000-hour registered apprenticeship in automotive technology, where students are paid to learn on the job, providing a path to better careers and higher salaries. Participating associate degree automotive students work for pay at a top employer, beginning in May after their first year and continuing for 15 months through August the following year. They work 32 hours a week and are in school for 10 hours a week as they finish their degree. It doesn't have to be a choice between work or school. It can be both.

## ELEMENTS OF THE REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIP MODEL

- \$10,000 WIOA voucher to help students pay for school and other expenses.
- A competitive starting wage with pay increases linked to completion of key learning outcomes.
- 20-hour co-op seminar and on-the-job coaching to students on how to thrive in the workplace. The co-op manager checks in weekly with both the student and employer.
- On-the-job mentor who ensures that students are developing advanced automotive skills beyond oil changes and tire rotations.
- Academic credit for skills developed on the apprenticeship to help students work more and attend school less.

## TIMELINE AND HOW TO APPLY

- Students enroll in the college's two-year automotive technology program.
- In their first semester, students apply for the registered apprenticeship.
- In the second semester, students complete the 20-hour co-op seminar and apply for a job with a participating employer.
- In May after their second semester, students begin their 2000-hour registered apprenticeship.
- Students work 32 hours a week and study 10 hours a week from May after their first year to the following August.
- After that August, if students meet expectations, the company will hire the student full-time.
