Sawyer Program

Partnership committee constructed a letter to the USFS Chief regarding the saw program. Region 9 has inherited region 8 but we don't call them regions anymore. Brenda Yankovich was included in the letter, and she came back with questions, on behalf of the Chief, regarding volunteer hours and these questions were answered. Just received notice the Forest Service has funded the saw training program, Mark has been trying to confirm this information but no response yet. BCHA has come up with an alternative saw structure based on the states, but this may not be needed anymore if the Forest Service has funded saw training.
