

## Wyoming's Wind River Back Country Horsemen have been busy this summer.



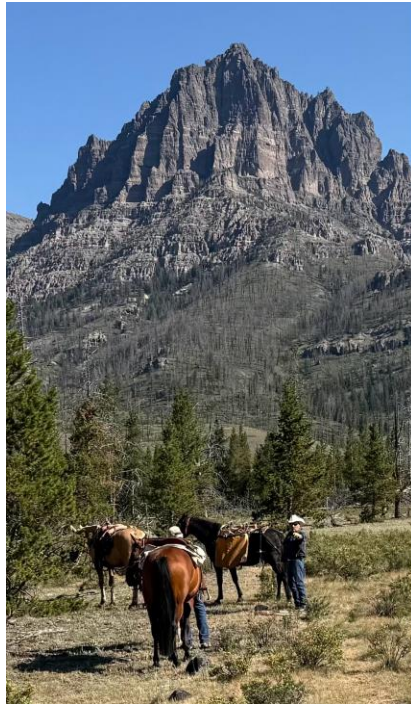
In May they demonstrated packing and hi-lining horses at the Wyoming Outdoor
