

# Poker Run

This is a fundraiser for our group.

*Note: this is what our group did. Change to fit your needs.*

Cost \$20 per person/hand

Winnings is a percentage of the entry fee.

1<sup>st</sup> place = 10%

2<sup>nd</sup> place = 5%

3<sup>rd</sup> place = 5%

Supplies needed:

- **5 containers to hold tokens.** Ice cream pails or kids sand pail work well. Drill hole in bottom of pail in case of rain.
- **String or light rope** to hang the containers
- **Chips or tokens.** We took a small branch and sliced 1/8 in pieces from it to create the tokens. Will need 5 tokens for each participant. Divide the tokens into 5 piles. Each pile will need to have a unique identifier. We used a marker to write on the tokens. Could also use 5 different color of poker chips.
- **Map of the area**
- **Deck of cards**
- **Print out of poker hand rankings** (From Strongest to Weakest)
- **Paper** to document participants and their hand

Instructions:

Prep the containers. Before the event, hang the containers. Place 1 pile of tokens in each container. Place them in a visible location. Accessible from horseback is a plus. Mark location of containers on a map.

Print maps for participants.

When participants get back to camp. For every token found, they can draw 1 card from the scuffled deck of cards. 4 tokens = 4 cards. 5 tokens = 5 cards.

We put letters on the tokens.

- If they could spell the word we were looking for (trail) – they could draw an additional card. The best 5 cards were entered.
- The team/person who could make the most words out of the letters won a prize.
