A BILL

To prohibit the use of Federal funds to implement any COVID–19 vaccine passport system, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Taxpayer Funding
5 for Vaccine Passports Act of 2021”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITING THE USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS TO IM-**
2 **PLEMENT ANY COVID-19 VACCINE PASSPORT**
3 **SYSTEM.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
5 sion of law, no funds appropriated under any Act may be
6 used for purposes of implementing, enforcing, or assisting
7 in the establishment of a COVID-19 vaccine passport sys-
8 tem (as defined in subsection (c)).

9 (b) STATE AND LOCAL USE OF COVID-19 VACCINE
10 PASSPORT SYSTEMS.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
11 sion of law, in the case of a State or a unit of local govern-
12 ment that implements, enforces, or assists in the establish-
13 ment of a COVID-19 vaccine passport system, no funds
14 appropriated under the Coronavirus Preparedness and Re-
15 sponse Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2020 (Public
16 Law 116-123), the Families First Coronavirus Response
17 Act (Public Law 116-127), the CARES Act (Public Law
18 116-136), the Paycheck Protection Program and Health
19 Care Enhancement Act (Public Law 116-139), division M
20 or N of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021 (Public
21 Law 116-260), or the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021
22 (Public Law 117-2) may be made available to such State
23 or unit of local government.

24 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this Act:

25 (1) COVID-19 VACCINE PASSPORT SYSTEM.—
26 The term “COVID-19 vaccine passport system”

1 means a system that requires proof (whether phys-
2 ical, electronic, or by any other means) of the vac-
3 cination status of an individual with respect to
4 COVID-19 as a condition of performing any action.

5 (2) STATE.—The term “State” means each of
6 the several States, the District of Columbia, and
7 each territory of the United States.
