1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

#### **3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Stop CRT Act".

#### 1 SEC. 3. FEDERAL FUNDS LIMITATION.

 $\mathbf{2}$ A Federal entity may not grant Federal funds to any 3 entity that teaches or advances any of the following: 4 (1) Any race is inherently superior or inferior 5 to any other race. (2) The United States is a fundamentally racist 6 7 8 (3) The Declaration of Independence or the 9 United States Constitution are fundamentally racist 10 documents. 11 (4) An individual's moral worth is determined 12 by his or her race. 13 (5) An individual, by virtue of his or her race, 14 is inherently racist or oppressive, whether con-15 sciously or unconsciously. 16 (6) An individual, because of his or her race, 17 bears responsibility for the actions committed by 18 members of his or her race.
