The Location

Epworth-by-the-Sea is a Christian conference and retreat center overlooking the Frederika River on beautiful St. Simons Island, Georgia, approximately a 2-hour drive from Beaufort. To view the facilities, go to epworthbythesea.org.

Registration

Rates are per person, based on the number of adults staying in the same room and include lodging for 2 nights plus 6 meals. Cost is \$308.26 per person staying 1 per room, and \$208.78 per person staying 2 per room, including tax.

Space is limited! A deposit of \$40 per person is due Sept. 4 (checks payable to St. Mark’s, memo “Parish Retreat”). The balance is payable no later than Oct. 15, 2019.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Cancellations after Sept. 20 will result in forfeiture of \$40 per person; cancellations after Oct. 4 will result in forfeiture of 1 night’s charge per person; cancellations after Oct. 11 will result in forfeiture of the entire per person charge.
