

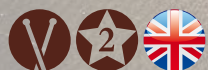

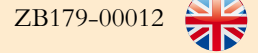
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# WHEATLAND HAT & COWL

## YARN

### Alpaca Merino DK

2 x 25gm

(cowl photographed in Frisby 104)

2 x 25gm

(hat photographed in Saxon 101)

## NEEDLES

### **Cowl:**

4½mm (no 7) (US 7) circular needle no more than 40 cm long

### **Hat:**

Set of 4 double-pointed 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

Set of 4 double-pointed 4½mm (no 7) (US 7) needles

## TENSION

21 sts and 34 rounds to 10 cm measured over patt using 4½mm (US 7) needles.

## FINISHED SIZE

Completed cowl measures 60 cm (23½ in) all round and is 20 cm (8 in) deep. Hat to fit an average size adult head.

## COWL

Using 4½mm (US 7) circular needle cast on 126 sts.

Place a marker between first and last cast-on sts to denote beg and end of rounds.

Work in patt as folls:

**Round 1 (RS):** \*K5, P9, rep from \* to end.

**Rounds 2 and 3:** As round 1.

**Round 4:** \*P5, K9, rep from \* to end.

**Rounds 5 and 6:** As round 4.

These 6 rounds form patt.

Cont in patt until cowl meas 20 cm, ending after round 2.

Cast off in patt.

## MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

## HAT

Using set of 4 double-pointed 4½mm (US 7) needles cast on 112 sts.

Distribute sts evenly over 3 of the 4 needles and, using 4th needle

and taking care not to twist cast-on edge, now work in rounds as folls:

Place a marker between first and last cast-on sts to denote beg and end of rounds.

Work in patt as folls:

**Round 1 (RS):** \*K5, P9, rep from \* to end.

**Rounds 2 and 3:** As round 1.

**Round 4:** \*P5, K9, rep from \* to end.

**Rounds 5 and 6:** As round 4.

These 6 rounds form patt.

Work in patt for a further 12 rounds.

Change to set of 4 double-pointed 4mm (US 6) needles.

Work 18 rounds.

Change to set of 4 double-pointed 4½mm (US 7) needles.

Work 33 rounds, ending after round 3.

### **Shape top**

**Round 1:** (P5, K4, K2tog, K3) 8 times. 104 sts.

**Round 2:** (P5, K8) 8 times.

**Round 3:** As round 2.

**Round 4:** (K2, K2tog, K1, P8) 8 times. 96 sts.

**Round 5:** (K4, P8) 8 times.

**Round 6:** As round 5.

**Round 7:** (P4, K4, K2tog, K2) 8 times. 88 sts.

**Round 8:** (P4, K7) 8 times.

**Round 9:** As round 8.

**Round 10:** (K2, K2tog, P7) 8 times. 80 sts.

**Round 11:** (K3, P7) 8 times.

**Round 12:** (K3, P3, P2tog, P2) 8 times. 72 sts.

**Round 13:** (P3, K6) 8 times.

**Round 14:** (P1, P2tog, K6) 8 times. 64 sts.

**Round 15:** (P2, K6) 8 times.

**Round 16:** (K2, P3, P2tog, P1) 8 times. 56 sts.

**Round 17:** (K2, P1, P2tog, P2) 8 times. 48 sts.

**Round 18:** (K2, P2, P2tog) 8 times. 40 sts.

**Round 19:** (P2, K2tog, K1) 8 times. 32 sts.

**Round 20:** (P2tog, K2) 8 times. 24 sts.

**Round 21:** (K2tog, K1) 8 times. 16 sts.

Break yarn and thread through rem 16 sts. Pull up tight and fasten off securely.
