In the book of Genesis is the story of Hagar. She is Sarah's Egyptian slave woman whom Sarah gives to Abraham as secondary wife and who would bear a child for him. After Hagar becomes pregnant, Sarah treats her harshly, and eventually Hagar flees from her mistress into the wilderness. Hagar has long represented the plight of the foreigner, the slave, and the sexually abused woman.

Today we have women who like Hagar are marginalized...often houseless or in shelters. Although they may receive food assistance, they do not receive assistance for feminine hygiene products.
