

**NEW YORK CITY COMMISSION ON HUMAN RIGHTS**

**Notice of Public Hearing**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN** the Commissioner of the New York City Commission on Human Rights (“the Commission”) by the New York City Charter that the Commission will hold a public hearing and take testimony on the issue of sexual harassment in the workplace across New York City and how New York City government can best address these issues.

- **When and where is the Hearing?** The public hearing will take place at 5:30 p.m. on Wednesday, December 6, 2017. The hearing will be held at the CUNY School of Law, Dave Fields Auditorium located at 2 Court Square, Long Island City, New York 11101. A wheelchair accessible entrance is available at 2 Court Square.
- **How do I testify at the Hearing?** Anyone can testify at the public hearing by:

  - **By Speaking at the Hearing.** Anyone who wants to speak at the hearing must sign up to do so. You can sign up by calling (212) 416-0128. You can also sign up for the hearing before it begins on December 6, 2017. If you plan to participate, we ask that you bring ten (10) double-sided copies of your written testimony to the hearing and please limit any oral remarks to three (3) minutes to allow enough time for questions and other panelists.
- **Is there a deadline to submit written testimony?** Yes. You must submit any written comments on or before December 6, 2017.

**What if I need assistance to participate in the Hearing?** Please notify the Commission if you need a reasonable accommodation for a disability to participate in the Hearing or language interpretation.
