This seminar introduces the concepts of documentary art and truth weaving to reflect on the role that media makers play in the configuration of horizons of justice and commonality. It presents a mixed framework of theory and justice, offering both reflective and methodological paths towards the articulation of innovative narratives against distrust and injustice.



**Pablo Martinez Zarate** is a Mexican filmmaker, writer, and artist. As head professor of documentary film and photography in the communications department at Iberoamericana University he coordinates the photography and the digital convergence labs. Zarate's work bridges memory, territory, and identity through film, photography, multimedia, and writing.
