Scholarships to assist female Nevada college students to attend the all-virtual 2021 National Conference of College Women Student Leaders (NCCWSL), MAY 25–26, 2021.

Scholarship Requirements:

- Must be a freshman, sophomore, or junior student with a minimum 3.0 GPA
 - Enrolled in a Nevada college/university OR
 - A Nevada resident enrolled in an out-of-state college/university
- Must submit the following required documents at <https://aauw-nv.aauw.net/nccwsl-registration/> by March 26, 2021:
 - Online application form
 - Short essay*
 - List of college and current community activities noting leadership roles you have held

Post-Conference requirements:

- Share NCCWSL & AAUW information with other college women (e.g., clubs, sororities, classes, etc.).
- Provide a video (preferred) or written document that describes your conference experience. This will be made available to AAUW Nevada branches.

***Essay:** One page maximum, one or two sentences per section

- Section A. Describe a leader who has inspired you to become one
- Section B Describe the qualities that you have that will assist you in becoming a leader.
- Section C. Describe how you plan to utilize this leadership experience in future activities.
