Volunteer Instructions:

What to Expect

- Please arrive 15 minutes before your shift is scheduled to start to allow time for sign in and collection of paperwork.
- Volunteers should plan to stay on-site for their full shift. If your schedule changes or you're unable to stay for the full time, please let your House Leader know. We'll do our best to work with you!
- You will be helping us rehab a home. The work varies including landscaping, painting, general cleaning, and many other tasks. The job you have signed up to do is important however all the work is and we may need to move you around to make sure everything gets done while it may not be what you were hoping to do, is absolutely necessary.
- If you are uncomfortable with a task or need more information to complete it please talk to your House leader. Your comfort and safety is our first priority.

What to Wear

- Thick soled shoes that cover your entire foot are required at all times while you're on the construction site, specifically work boots or sneakers. Absolutely NO sandals or open-toe shoes are allowed.
- Work is both inside and outside - please dress appropriately for the weather. Shorts are acceptable.
- Clothes you don't mind getting dirty are strongly encouraged - paint, adhesives and other materials may stain your clothing.
- Please do not wear jewelry or clothing with loose straps or strings, because such items can get caught on tools or other objects. Jewelry can be lost or damaged easily.

What to Bring

- Water is provided on site, but a personal water bottle is a good idea.
- Lunch will be served on site between 11:45 p.m. and 12:45 p.m.
- Tools will be provided on site but you may bring your own if you have them. Work gloves are highly recommended. Other suggested items include: rake, hammer, utility knife, tape measure. Leon County is not responsible for lost or damaged personal items.
- Please do NOT bring: purses, pets or children under the age of 16.
