Overview & Background

The District has the need to move forward with some accessibility updates at Crow Island to accommodate individuals. The Administration shared information regarding these needs with the Facilities Subcommittee at the January 22, 2018, meeting. Green Associates surveyed the building and made several recommendations to make the building more accessible. There is quite a bit of work that needs to be completed in order to meet the standard. With the Future Ready D36 process we hope to address these needs within all of our facilities, but in order to ensure that those that need access are accommodated, Administration recommends moving forward with the following:

- Ramp out of the classroom in the first-grade wing out into the courtyard
- Ramp out of northwest wing between the fourth-grade wing and nurse's office out to playground
- Renovation of bathroom in nurse's office
- Renovation of bathroom on lower-level
- Curb cuts in east sidewalk
- Asphalt work east side drive

Green Associates has estimated that these renovations will cost approximately \$130,000. Green Associates is currently working on the drawings, and our hope is to get this out to bid in the next few weeks so that we can have the work completed this summer.

The Administration has also met with the Stewardship Group to make them aware of the changes that we are looking to make. We hope to bring forward a presentation of the bid to the Board for approval at the March meeting. The cost of these renovations will be built into the FY2019 budget out of the Capital Projects fund.
