Informational Item: Illinois State Compliance Visit

The Illinois State Board of Education authorizes the Regional Offices of Education to conduct Compliance Visits of the school districts within its boundary area every four years. During February 20-22, 2018, the North Cook Compliance Team consisting of Richard Duran, Shirley Bloom, Tom Bookler, and Gary Lonquist inspected facilities, records, policies, programs, credentials, and curriculum to determine the Winnetka School District 36 compliance with state regulations.

The District's central office administrative team, along with Adam Rappaport (Director of Buildings and Grounds), were instrumental in ensuring all materials were prepared and ready for inspection. Dr. Daniel Ryan also escorted the visitors on school visits.

The District received its final report on May 9, 2018, and is attached for School Board review. It is noted that there are several commendations with no areas of noncompliance or concern recorded. The District was determined to be in "Full Compliance."
