Reaching ALL Learners Update

Targeted Indicator	Highlights
2.1 - Provide meaning and context for our major assessments for teachers, parents and students (2-year goal)	Created a draft student profile utilizing the Illuminate digital platform. The profile includes standardized assessment data and lays the groundwork for a comprehensive student dashboard.

<p>2.3 - Implement K-2 Intervention Model of Support</p>	<p>The RtI Committee has completed a final draft of a universal letter that will go home to parents when students are recommended for intervention in reading or math. This letter will be used by all school buildings no later than the beginning of the 2018-2019 school year.</p>
<p>2.4 - Establish a District-wide Special Education Service Delivery Model</p>	<p>A draft of the visual continuum that represents consistent District-wide service delivery options has been shared with all members of Administration and the Department of Student Services for review/feedback. It is anticipated that a final draft will be available for Board review in April, 2018.</p>
<p>2.5- Ensure all students demonstrate the outcomes of utilizing the design thinking process (collaboration, empathy, communication, resilience) in their experiential learning opportunities. (2-year goal)</p>	<p>Science and STEAM facilitators met in March to plan next steps in collaboration for MakerSpace and integration of the design thinking process into the classrooms. In 2018-2019, STEAM facilitators will attend Science curriculum team meetings to further the collaboration and continue to make meaningful connections between the two spaces so that our students have increased opportunities for experiential learning.</p> <p>Planning is fully underway for the New Trier Township Technology and Innovation Showcase to be held on April 28, 2018 from 8:30 am -12:30 pm. Students, teachers and administrators will be sharing their successes in how technology and innovation is being integrated into the school day.</p>
