CUMAC is a non-profit organization dedicated to feeding people and changing lives. It works to alleviate hunger and its root causes in Paterson, Passaic County and New Jersey. CUMAC has been fighting hunger for over 30 years. With the help of their supporters and community partners, CUMAC operates an impressive array of programs that serve as a social safety net within the community of Paterson and beyond.

UMCOR provides humanitarian relief and disaster response to people in more than 80 countries, including the United States. After flood waters have receded, wounds have been tended, basic needs met, and the world's attention has faded, The United Methodist Church continues to be present by providing ongoing assistance.
