

AP Test Registration Window Is Open October 1 - October 31: Students enrolled in **AP** classes have the option of taking AP Exams in May. These are optional exams, but students in the classes are highly encouraged to take the exams to earn college credit and/or college course placement.

The fee for EACH Advanced Placement test is \$96. Any tests cancelled before testing or unused on test day will incur a \$40 fee (set by the College Board, not LC so this is non-negotiable).

REQUIRED STEPS FOR REGISTRATION

- 1. Go on to your AP College Board account and select <u>YES</u> or <u>NO</u> for every AP class that you are enrolled in this year to commit to taking or not taking each exam. THIS STEP IS REQUIRED, EVEN IF YOU AREN'T TAKING THE EXAM.
- 2. Determine your method of payment:
 - a. I will pay the full amount for my exams AND I will be paying with cash or check.
 - o Bring payment to the Business Office. If you need to pay over time, discuss a plan with the Business Office.
 - o Bring completed AP Exam Registration form (purple sheet) and mark every test you plan to take.
 - b. I will pay the full amount for my exams AND I will be paying online with a credit card.
 - Go to <u>wa-spokane.intouchreceipting.com</u> or <u>www.lctigers</u> (click on Pay Fees), follow the directions, and pay. You do **NOT** need to complete the AP Exam registration form (purple sheet).
 - c. I qualify for free/reduced lunch or state assistance for \$0 exams.
 - See Mrs. Meyer in the Public Office during the school day or at lunch outside of the library to get the fee waiver form and discuss options.
 - Take the fee waiver form home for parent signature.
 - o Return fee waiver form and AP Exam Registration form (purple sheet) to Mrs. Meyer.

If you require a late exam due to a conflict, see Mrs. Meyer in the Public Office to see if you are eligible. There is a late fee of \$45 associated with most late exams.
