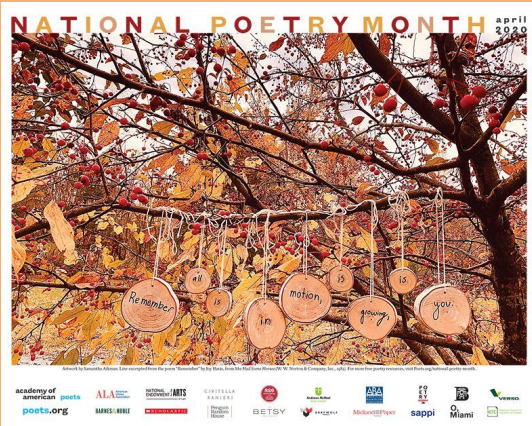

DIY Poetry

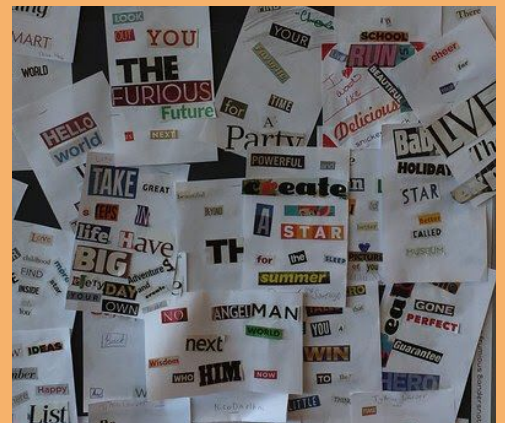
For the past few years, we have done this in the Children's Room. If you've come in, you may have seen this display, or even made one of your own. Here's how:

Supplies:

- Old magazines or newspapers
- Scissors
- Paper
- Glue, glue stick, or tape

Directions:

- Use old magazines or newspapers that you don't need anymore.
- Cut out words or phrases that you can use to make a poem. Make sure to choose different colors and sizes to make your poem look more interesting.
- Look through all the words and phrases, organizing them to create a poem.
- Once you have decided what your poem will say, glue or tape the words and phrases to the paper.
- Proudly display your poem!
- Make as many poems as you want.
