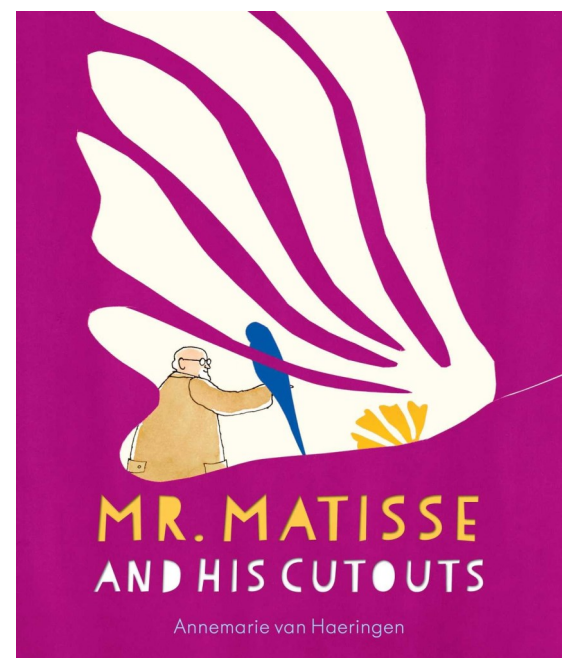

Henri Matisse (1869-1944) was a French artist known for his use of color. Towards the end of his life, when he was too sick to paint, he began making art from paper cutouts.



Supplies:

white paper, colored paper, scissors, glue

Instructions:

1. Cut shapes out of colored paper. They can be abstract, or they can be real objects or people.
2. Arrange the cut-out shapes on your paper.
3. When you are happy with the arrangement of the cut-out shapes, glue them to the paper.
