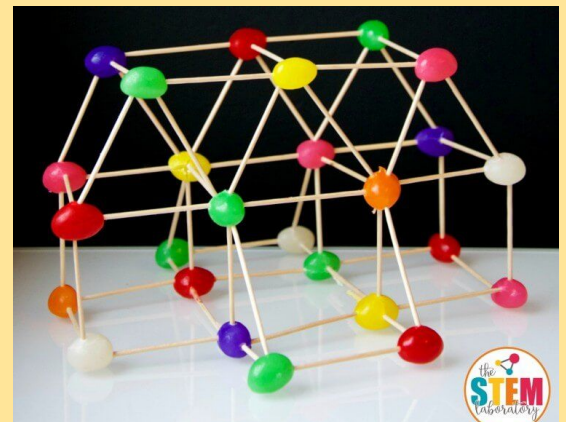
**HOW TO CELEBRATE NATIONAL JELLY BEAN DAY

Jelly Bean STEM Structures

All you need are jelly beans and toothpicks. Carefully pierce the jelly bean with a toothpick. Younger children may need help with this. Using the toothpicks as connectors, you can make any shape you want. Try seeing what is the tallest structure you can build, or the widest. Can your structure hold a book on it without collapsing? Use your imagination to create anything you want!
