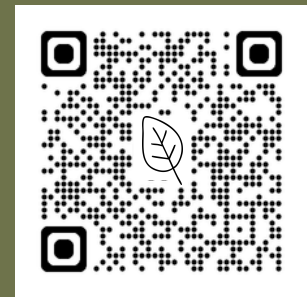


Funds for Technical Assistance in the Alexander Valley

If so, the Sonoma RCD is providing **FREE** technical assistance and consultations in project development or planning. Our technical staff can support with the following:

- Distribution Uniformity Testing
- Pump Efficiency Testing
- Weather-Based Irrigation Controllers
- Alternative Water Source (such as rainwater catchment)
- Ponds and Reservoirs
- Water Banking: *applying riparian water inland during the wet season to save in-ground for later season use*
- Drip Irrigation
- Stormwater Runoff Management
- Lawn/Turf Conversion into Native Drought-Tolerant Plants
- Water Meters
- Conservation Tillage
- Cover Cropping
- Compost
- Dry Farming
- Frost Fans
