

Invasive Species Management Workshop

Join us for a hands-on workshop to learn how to identify and manage invasive species on your property. While we'll focus on species commonly encroaching in post-fire landscapes, all community members are welcome.

The workshop will begin with a presentation by Jason Mills of Ecological Solutions, offering an overview of invasive species and management strategies. We'll then head out onto the property for a hands-on exploration, where you'll receive practical, real-world guidance and see examples up close.

Please come prepared for outdoor conditions: wear closed-toe shoes and long sleeves, and bring gloves if you have them (a limited number will be available). This workshop is funded through a National Fish and Wildlife Foundation grant.

Jason Mills is a Senior Fire and Restoration Ecologist and founder of Ecological Solutions, with over 25 years of experience managing natural resources across Northern California. He specializes in invasive species management and ecological approaches to fuel reduction, including the use of prescribed fire.
