## Tournament Info:

- **Entry Fee:** \$30 through March 21; \$40 thereafter. Registration closes March 27 at midnight.
- US Chess Membership is required. Discount link provided below.
- 5 round event: Swiss System, Game 25 mins; delay 5 sec, and US Chess rated.
- Tournament limited to 30 players a section; sections divided by grade and US Chess rating.
- School awards will be determined by combining the top 4 player scores for each team.

## Schedule:

- First round will begin as close to 9:00am as possible. Please arrive early!
- Lunch will be around 11:30am after round 2 is finished.
- Last round begins around 3:00pm and the award ceremony will be over around 5:00pm.

- Students will be able to play up to 5 rounds (not an elimination tournament). Players are expected to know the rules. A link to rules and expectations is provided below.
- Chess boards and pieces, and chess clocks will be provided. Players should bring their own notation sheets and pencils.
- Parents or guardians are not allowed in the playing area once the round starts. Parents may escort their child to the playing area and take pictures before the round begins.
