Dress Code: Students may only wear Rodeo themed OR Sunday-best attire. All Rodeo themed and Sunday-best attire must adhere to the following guidelines:

- **Dresses may be sleeveless, but the straps must completely cover undergarments**
- **No spaghetti straps, strapless dresses or tops, see-through blouses, or any other style that shows undergarments**
- **No dresses/skirts, or dresses/skirts with slits, that go above the knee**
- **No shorts, sweatpants, or joggers**
- **No holes, rips, or frays allowed**
- **No clothing that reveals the midriff**
- **No low-cut attire that reveals cleavage - any at all**
- **No muscle shirts**
- **No see-through clothing**
- **No clothing/accessories referring to alcohol, drugs, tobacco, weapons, nudity, gang affiliation, violence, vulgar/obscene language or images.**
- **No clothing that insults any race, religion, gender, ethnicity or disability**

Students not in dress code or who behave in a manner not in keeping with Aristoi values will be asked to contact a parent and leave. **Additionally, cell phones and electronic devices are not permitted.**

Students will not be admitted later than 7:00 pm. Students will not be allowed to leave until 9:00 pm unless accompanied by that student's parent/guardian. Once a student leaves the dance, re-admittance is not allowed.

Only Aristoi scholars in 7th-8th grade are permitted to attend; outside guests are not permitted.
