FJUHS Students Outperform County and State!

Dear FJUHS Staff Members, Students, Parents/Guardians, and Community,

The statewide assessment, known as the [Smarter Balanced](#) exam, taken in the spring of each school year, is part of the statewide accountability system known as the [California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress](#), or CAASPP. The academic assessment covers three subject areas - English Language Arts (ELA), mathematics, and science, and is administered for students in grades 3-8 and grade 11. As FJUHS is grades 9-12, **our results are for grade 11 only.**

Assessment results for the 2022/23 administration of the exam were [publicly released](#) today by the California Department of Education.

FJUHS students outperformed the **statewide average** in all three subject areas in grade 11:

12 percentage points higher in ELA
17 percentage points higher in math
10 percentage points higher in science

FJUHS students outperformed the **countywide average** in all three subject areas in grade 11:

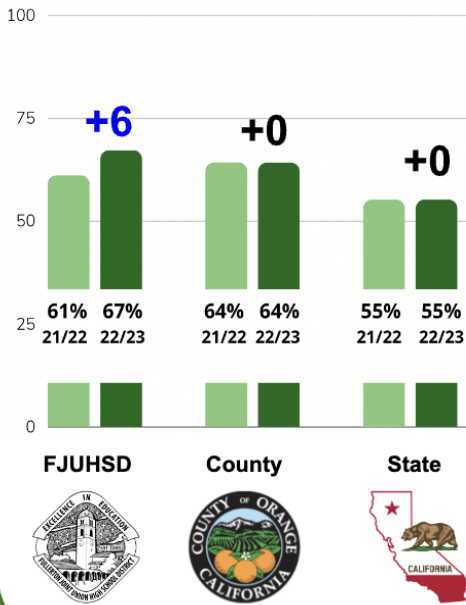
3 percentage points higher in ELA
6 percentage points higher in math
1 percentage point higher in science

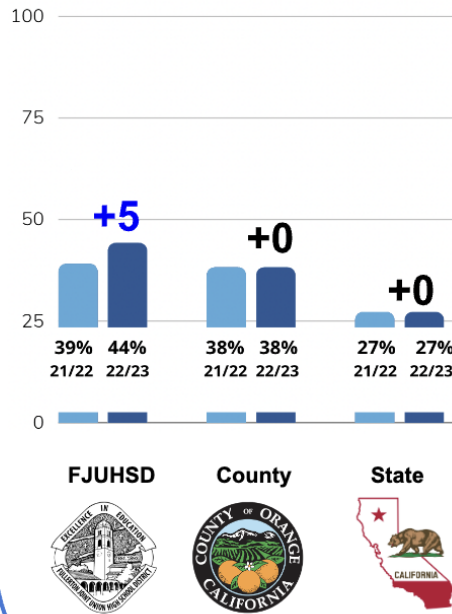

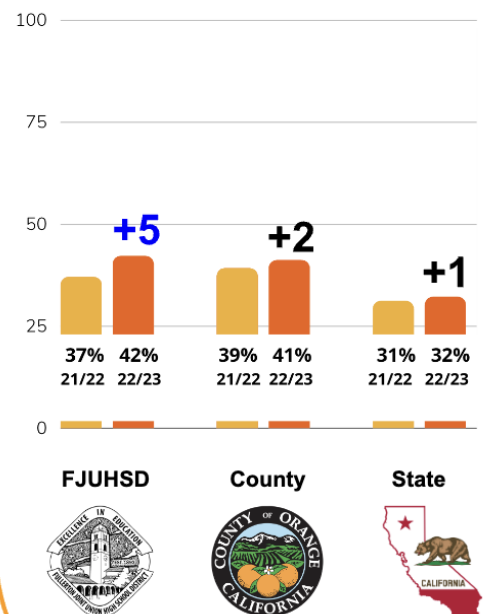
CAASPP - ELA GRADE 11 % Met or Exceeded
