Academic Information

Academics

In order to participate in graduation and Senior Activities you must meet the Fullerton Joint Union High School District graduation requirements.

Attendance/Tardies

It is important that Seniors continue to attend all classes and be on time.

All unexcused absences and excessive tardies can lead to Saturday School and the loss of some or all Senior Activities and/or other extra-curricular and co-curricular activities (athletics, performing arts, etc).

Students with excessive absences and tardies WILL NOT BE ALLOWED to participate in Senior Activities. All Saturday Schools MUST be cleared if you are going to attend Senior Activities. Remember that all activity sales are final - NO REFUNDS.

Senior Accounts

Fines

All students must have their student account balances paid off in order to participate in any Senior Activities. Fines include but are not limited to material fees, athletic fees, textbook and library fines.

You must be cleared of fines BEFORE you purchase Prom tickets (not at the time you purchase your ticket). The last day to clear your fines before Prom is at lunch on Friday, March 11th.

The Activities Office will stop accepting checks on Friday, April 22nd, and will stop accepting credit cards on Friday, May 13th.

For students who have fines, but did not attend Prom or incurred fines after Prom), all fines MUST be cleared by Tuesday, May 24th in order to receive your graduation tickets.

Prom

Prom will be held on Saturday, April 30th from 8:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. The following is the schedule of ticket sales:

- April 11th-14th for \$80 with IFL and \$90 w/o IFL
- April 18th-22nd for \$90 with IFL and \$100 w/o IFL
- April 25th-28th for \$120 for EVERYONE

You may purchase tickets in the Activities Office during break and lunch. Tickets WILL NOT be sold during student class time. All fines must be cleared prior to purchase!

The last day to purchase tickets will be Thursday, April 28th. NO EXCEPTIONS! Purchase your tickets early for the best price!!!

The dress code will be strongly enforced. If a student is not dressed appropriately, they will not be allowed into the dance. Please see an administrator prior to purchasing your attire if you have any questions or concerns.

The doors will close at 8:30 p.m. and no students will be allowed to leave before 10:30 p.m.

Walking Buddies

Friday, May 6th by 3:00 PM is the deadline to turn in your Walking Buddies paperwork to the Activities Office - one form per Walking Buddies. Buddies will need to turn in the form together with their FUHS IDs (signed by both sets of parents).

Once you have submitted the Walking Buddies form, you will NOT be allowed to make any changes so choose your buddy wisely.

If you have not submitted a form by 3:00 p.m. on Friday, May 6th in the Activities Office you will be assigned a Walking Buddy at random.

Cap Decorations

This year, all seniors can decorate their graduation cap. However, ALL must follow dress code guidelines. If dress code guidelines are not met, the cap will be confiscated on graduation day and you will be given another cap.

Graduation Practice

Graduation practice will be on Tuesday, May 31st at 7:00 a.m. in the stadium. This practice is **MANDATORY** for all graduating Seniors who plan to participate in the graduation ceremony. You must be on time! If you do not attend Graduation Practice, you WILL NOT be able to walk at Graduation.

Graduation Ceremony

Time, Location, Tickets, & Parking The Graduation Ceremony will be held at Fullerton Joint Union High School Stadium on Wednesday, June 1st at 7:00 p.m. Please park in the Fullerton College parking structure across from the stadium. Each student will receive 9 guest tickets for the ceremony (only 9 tickets can be given due to limited seating). Tickets will be given to students only. Tickets will NOT be distributed to anyone else. Ceremony tickets will be distributed after graduation practice with the cap and gown. Please note that due to fire regulations ALL attendees, including children and infants, require a ticket.

Dress Code

Only approved tassels, honor stoles, medallions, etc. may be worn. Students NOT dressed appropriately will not be allowed to participate in the Graduation Ceremony. Items **not allowed** include but are not limited to:

- High heels
- Bare feet
- Inappropriate caps or gowns
- Floral leis and any other accessories, not school-issued

Arrival Time

The procession will begin promptly at 7:00 p.m. Seniors are required to arrive at 5:30 p.m. Seniors must meet at the gymnasium. If you are late you will NOT be allowed to participate in the ceremony.

Graduate Conduct & Prohibited Items
All graduating seniors will be
checked for inappropriate items at
the stadium entrance. If any items
are found, they will be taken away,
and depending on the items students
may be asked to leave. Inappropriate
items include, but are not limited to

- Cell phones
- Cameras/video games
- Purses
- Make-up/cosmetics
- Air horns, balloons, confetti, noisemakers, etc.
- Food, drinks, or gum

School officials will remove any student who distracts from the dignity of the ceremony. Any student under the influence of drugs or alcohol will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony and will be arrested.

Guest Information

In order to make this a pleasant event for all guests, please inform your friends and family of the following:

- No noisemakers, confetti, or other disruptive party items.
- Strollers are also not allowed inside the stadium,
- Balloons, and signs will have to be left outside the stadium.
