





#### from Cara Hart, Dírector

I recently received the latest edition of the Vesterheim magazine which covers the 200 Years of Norwegians in America. What a wonderful magazine telling of the celebrations that will be held commemorating the anniversary of the first organized Norwegian emigration to America. In case you are wondering the group of 25 left from Stavanger, Norway on July 4, 1825, on the ship *Restauration*.

In reading the articles, I couldn't help but reflect on the nationalities that settled in Jackson County. Coming from many countries, these emigrants did not know what lay before them and where they would call home. Yet, they settled, homesteaded the land, cleared land for crops, built communities and in many cases prospered. However times were difficult for some, and they failed.



The History Room has numerous files on the communities these emigrants settled in and what those who came after them continued to do in their footsteps. Whether it be the Norwegians, Swedes, Irish, Bohemians, Germans, or another nationality, visiting the History Room will offer you many resources with which to discover who your ancestors were, the communities they settled, and the role they played in making Jackson County what it is today.
