No-Cost Workshops Available

Education Service – We provide in-and-out of classroom supports with immediate tutorial intervention supports to ensure success in the college coursework with an outcome of achieving an associate degree in the degree paths available within the college called Educating Disability Groups through Education (EDGE).

Employment Services - designed to assist individuals with mild to moderate developmental disabilities in obtaining either employer paid jobs or paid internship experience.
