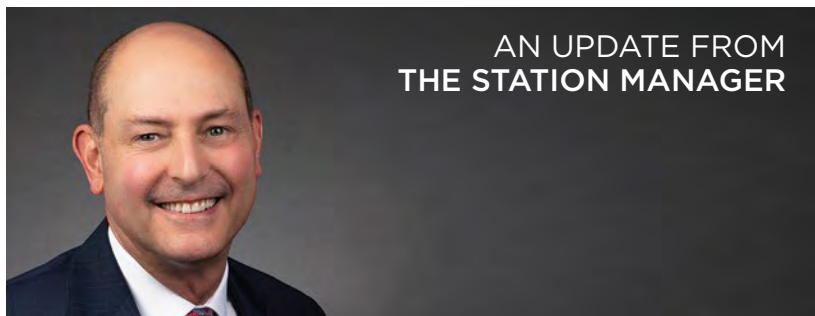

Compelling stories from our nation's largest estuary are once again front and center during MPT's 19th annual Chesapeake Bay Week, featuring more than 22 hours of bay-focused programming.

On Monday, April 17 at 8pm, discover a fascinating untold history in *Water's Edge: Black Watermen of the Chesapeake*. Meet unsung Marylanders who revolutionized an industry and dreamed beyond their circumstances – and those keeping the tradition alive today.

The centuries-old story of Maryland's founding enters a new chapter on Tuesday, April 18 at 8pm. *Discovering the Dove* follows a team of shipbuilders as they attempt to recreate the historic Dove and learn more about the past in the process. Then, at 8:30pm, discover how *Kent County's Storied Landscape* has shaped the county's history from ancient times to the modern day.

And on Thursday, April 20 at 8pm: if you can't beat 'em – eat 'em! The latest installment of MPT's popular *Eatin'* series, *Eatin' Blue Catfish*, explores a delectable way to manage an invasive species.

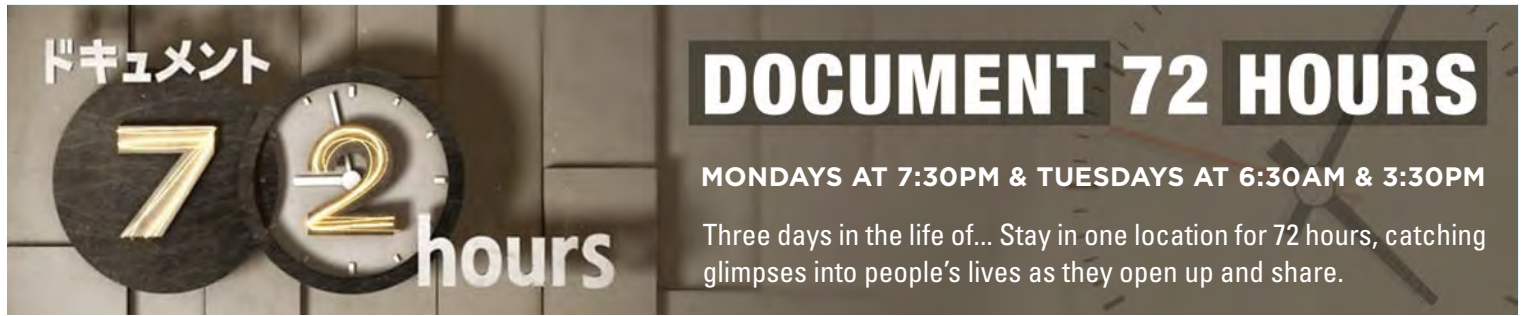

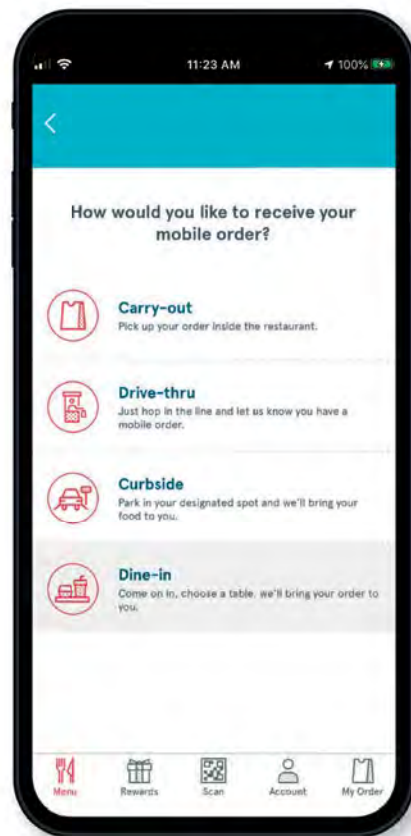


