Prerequisite

Female-identifying, 16 years of age by June 1, 2023

Able to provide proof of work authorization in the U.S.*

*Please note, all Internships require work authorization in the U.S. (Must be a U.S. Citizen, U.S. permanent resident or possess other unrestricted U.S. work authorization and will not require sponsorship for U.S. work authorization now or anytime in the future.)

Applicant Must

Be able to attend the internship the entire 5 days between the hours of **8:30AM and 5:00PM** each day

Provide their own transportation to and from the Citi campus

Interns will be paid **\$12/hour**

Future opportunities to apply to Citi's Women in IT **6-week high school** and **10-week college** internships are available for those that attend the one-week internship

Essay Requirements

- Essay must be between 500 and 1500 words.
- While prior technology experience is not required, if you do have any technology experience (informal/formal) it is recommended to include within your essay as appropriate.
- Do not include your name anywhere in your essay.
- Essays will be reviewed and ranked based on overall organization, content, and future technology aspirations.

- Make sure to save your essay as either a Word Doc or a PDF and attach it to your email. No links.
- Please include your name and contact info in the body of the email.
- Your essay should answer the following two prompts (make sure to include answers to both):
 - Describe experiences you have had that would allow you to be successful in this internship.
 - Describe an experience you had working in a team and what you learned from it.

Requirements to Apply

- Step 1 and 2 above need to be completed submitted by midnight on December 31, 2022.
- Applicant must live in Jacksonville or surrounding areas/counties.
- Those selected to move to the interview portion of the application process will be notified via email in late January 2024.
