

CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Ponte Vedra Chapter NSDAR may award a scholarship each year to a graduating high school senior meeting the following eligibility criteria:

- Student is enrolled in one of the following high schools in St. Johns County, Florida: Bartram High School, Beachside High School, Creekside High School, Nease High School, or Ponte Vedra High School.
- Student exhibits good academic achievement and character.
- Student has maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or better (where A is equal to 4.0) during the entire high school enrollment period.
- Student is a citizen of the United States.

This scholarship will be awarded on the merits of the application without regard to race, religion, sex, or national origin. No affiliation with the DAR is necessary.

The application package must be compiled in the order described in the checklist:

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION IN ORDER OF SUBMISSION

CHECK LIST:

- Scholarship application
- Statement of need, if applicable (maximum of 1 page)
- Statement explaining applicant's reasons for attending college, choice of college, choice of major, educational goals, career plans, and how the award will assist financially (maximum of 1000 words)



- Transcript of grades and GPA for the entire high school enrollment period (an official transcript from each school attended)
- Resumé including (but not limited to) extra-curricular activities, honors received, scholastic achievements, community service or volunteer activities, employment history, and other significant accomplishments (maximum of 2 pages)
- Dated and signed current letters of recommendation from two people who are in authority from the applicant's current high school; the letters should include details of applicant's abilities, work habits, integrity, and long-term potential
- Photocopy of proof of United States citizenship: birth certificate, naturalization papers, or information page of U.S. Passport
- Recent photograph that can be used in a news release

REQUIRED FORMATTING AND CONDITIONS

- The application should be typed or word-processed using 12 pt. Times New Roman or Arial font with 1" margins on single side of 8 1/2" x 11" sheets of white paper.
- Completed application package should be stapled in the top, left-hand corner.
- Incomplete or incorrect applications WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Ponte Vedra Chapter Scholarship Committee will consider fully completed applications only. Incorrect or partially completed applications will be discarded. No record or supporting documents will be returned.

The Ponte Vedra Chapter Scholarship Committee will choose the student to be awarded the scholarship, and funds will be provided directly to the student for use in payment of college fees. The awardee and high school will be notified when a decision is made.

All transcripts, letters of recommendation, and other requested documents must be mailed to the address below in a single envelope postmarked no later than March 31, 2024.
