

Nease High School AP Exam Registration 2018

You are currently enrolled in one or more Advanced Placement courses this year. The culmination of the course is an examination given in May that you are required to take.

According to school policy, students who have "AP" in the title of any of their courses must take the corresponding AP exam, without a fee for the exam. Students who are not currently enrolled in an AP course have the option of taking an AP Exam; however, the exam will cost \$94.

Alternate AP exams must be ordered if there is a conflict with another AP or IB Exam. The dates for alternate AP exams will be May 23<sup>rd</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>, and 25<sup>th</sup>.

\* Concerning conflicts with IB or AP Exams: Please note that if a student has an IB exam on the same date/time as their AP exam, the IB exam takes precedent over an AP exam. This will result in an alternate AP exam date. After viewing the enclosed 2018 AP/IB exam schedule, it is the student's responsibility to notify Ms. Messenger of the conflict. Together the student and Ms. Messenger will determine whether an alternate AP exam is warranted. **There is no charge for an alternate AP exam that is in conflict with an IB exam or another AP exam.**

\* Concerning other conflicts (personal/non-IB related): After viewing the 2018 AP/IB exam schedule, it is the student's responsibility to notify Ms. Messenger if he/she is unable to sit for an AP exam on the scheduled date. Together the student and Ms. Messenger will determine whether an alternate AP exam is warranted. There is an additional charge of \$45 for these alternate exams.

\* Concerning "No- Shows": If you are registered to take an AP Exam and do not sit for the exam, you will be charged \$94, to cover the cost of the exam.
