We have been successful for 20 years due to the unwavering support from the community. We look forward to your continued support so we may provide a new book to each child that attends the event at Ferns Park this April 26th.

We started out twenty years ago in Heritage Plaza, quickly outgrew that location and moved to Freeman Park where the event was hosted for two years. Ultimately, moving to Ferns Park in order to accommodate all the families in attendance. Since our inception we have given away more than \$50,000 worth of books to the children of Yolo County.

“Día de los Niños-Day of the Children” is celebrated nationally as a day for parents, families, and communities to value, celebrate and uplift all children.

Community groups and agencies have been invited to host their own individual booths and provide activities for children to enjoy.
