## **Club Oasis will be open for meetings beginning Saturday May 30, 2020.**

Below is the TEMPORARY meeting schedule as well as the list of precautions we are taking to protect our fellowship from the COVID-19 virus:

- Monday through Friday meetings will be held at 10am; 3pm and 7pm
- Saturday meetings will be held at 10am; 12pm; 1:30pm and 5pm
- Sunday meetings will be held at 10am and 2pm (The 8pm meeting is for our NA fellowship)

All meetings are open, and the type of meeting will be determined by the chairperson

1. Doors will be open 10 minutes before the start of the meeting
2. Please enter through the parking lot entrance only
3. A touch free thermometer will be used to check temperatures on all who enter the club. Anyone having a temperature over 100 or not feeling well will be denied entrance
4. We ask that if you have been knowingly exposed to COVID-19 in the past 14 days that you do not enter the club.
5. Masks must be worn properly at all times. You must provide your own mask.
6. The total number of meeting participants will not exceed 25
7. No congregating on the deck before or after meetings
8. We ask that everyone vacate the property within 15 minutes following the end of the meeting
9. No coffee or snacks will be provided. You will be allowed to bring your own coffee or soft drink with you
10. There will be no holding hands during the Lord's prayer, and we ask everyone maintain the social distancing recommendation of 6ft at all times
11. The club will be disinfected after each meeting and we ask that you help by wiping down your chair with the cleaning products available

We are hopeful to be able to get back to our normal meeting schedule in the near future.
