

The Convention-Goer's Guide IN CASE OF EMERGENCY - 207-650-6070

Parking - Important Update: Please Park in the Casino Parking Garage, across the street from the Cross Center on Main Street! Hollywood Casino at 500 Main Street is directly across from the Cross Center's Rotunda entrance (at the corner of Main Street and Buck Street) that Convention guests should use.



The University of Maine Basketball teams have games in the arena the same day, therefore, the Southwest Entrance will only be accessible for UMaine Basketball ticket holders. Handicap parking is also available at the garage.

Directions:

Please set your destination as 500 Main Street (the casino garage) then cross the street to the Rotunda Entrance at the Convention Center. Look for Red-apron Ambassadors at every entrance to assist you as you arrive.

Check-In - Check-in will be from 7:30 a.m. to 8:45 a.m. on Saturday, October 28, at the Cross Center in Bangor. Registration is alphabetical by last name. All clergy, delegates, alternates, and guests must check-in. Only delegates authorized to vote will be given an electronic voting pad. Registration will cease at 8:45 a.m. Any delegate who wishes to be seated for the 198th Convention after that time must present him/herself to "Late Registration" in the lobby.

Refreshments and Meals - Coffee service will be available throughout the convention. A full hot breakfast and a buffet lunch are included in your registration. Breakfast will be offered beginning at 7:45 a.m.
